FREE SCHOOL MEALS

Any parents of Reception, KS1 or KS2 pupils who are receiving qualifying benefit can apply for extra funding for the school. Although this is called Free School Meals, it does not mean that child has to have a school lunch if you would prefer them not to, but it will bring additional funding into the school. You are able to check eligibility by contacting Wiltshire Council at www.wiltshire.gov.uk/freeschoolmeals or by completing a form from the school office.
